The rock provided has been washed to remove excess dirt to make it easier to decorate. If you would like to wash it again before you decorate it, make sure that you let it dry before adding color.

Please return your rock to St. Aloysius at your convenience and we will add a clear coat seal to your rock before we place it at the future grotto. (NOTE: Please do not use washable paint or water-based markers to decorate your rock as the clear coat seal will erase your design.)

If you would prefer to decorate your rock at the church, please bring your rock Wednesday, June 23 from 5:30-8:00 to the parish hall and use the permanent markers provided by the church to decorate it. There will also be a free taco bar with a marshmallow roast for dessert AND additional opportunities for crafting fun. Everyone is invited to pop in for some yummy food and creative activities.
